In Math Analysis you will begin with Functions and Graphs; Polynomial, Power and Rational Functions; Exponential, Logistic and Logarithmic Functions; Trigonometric Functions; Analytic Trigonometry; Vectors, Parametric and Polar Equations; Systems and Matrices; Analytic Geometry; Discrete Math and an introduction to Calculus. Graphing Calculators will be used as a tool. All assignments must be turned in prior to taking a unit test in order to have the opportunity to do test corrections.

MATERIALS

1. A three ring binder including:
 - Dividers for quizzes, homework, classwork
2. A spiral notebook for notes – 3 subject preferably.
3. Pencil – Math is not a pen subject.
4. Loose leaf paper
